Storage and Stability

Store kit at -70°C. To avoid repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw cycles aliquot components into smaller quantities. Protect reporter component from light.

Always include RNase inhibitor at manufacturer recommended concentrations in Cas enzyme reactions.

Scientific Background

Cas13a is an RNA-guided RNA endonuclease that belongs to the class 2 type VI CRISPR-Cas system (1). Cas13a possesses both RNA recognition and cleavage activities and cleaves RNA through conserved basic residues within its two HEPN domains (2). Activated Cas13a also induces collateral cleavage of nearby non-targeted RNAs in a nonspecific manner (3). This property of the Cas13a enzyme has been leveraged for the development of sensitive and robust nucleic acid detection tools with applications in both basic research and therapeutics development (4).

Reaction Protocol

Other Materials Required

- Filter pipette tips
- Nuclease free water
- Nuclease free microcentrifuge tubes
- Half-area solid black 96-well plate
- Microplate sealing tape
- Fluorescent microplate reader
- ssRNA substrate

Step 1: Thaw the active enzyme on ice. Prepare 1X Reaction Buffer with nuclease free water. Reconstitute reporter in nuclease free water. Equilibrate the buffer, reporter, guide RNA, and ssRNA substrate to ambient temperature.

Step 2: Prepare the following working solutions with 1X Reaction Buffer:

- o 4X final concentration of Active Cas13 enzyme
- o 4X final concentration of guide RNA
- o 2X final concentration of substrate/reporter mix

Step 3: In a half-area solid black 96-well plate, add the following components and pre-incubate at room temperature for 10 minutes;

Component 1. 10 µL of 4X Active Cas13 Component 2. 10 µL of 4X guide RNA

Note: A blank control can be set up as outlined in step 3 by replacing the enzyme working solution with an equal volume of the reaction buffer.

Step 4: To each assay well, add 20 µL of the 2X substrate/reporter mix. Shake the plate for 1 minute on a tabletop orbital shaker. Seal the assay wells with microplate sealing tape and incubate at 37°C for 15-30 minutes.

Step 5: Equilibrate the plate to ambient temperature and then remove the microplate sealing tape. Read fluorescence on a microplate reader.
